BYLAW NO. 6-2014

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 9-2013 KNOWN AS THE ZONING BYLAW

The Council of the Town of St. Walburg in the Province of Saskatchewan in open meeting enacts to amend the Zoning Bylaw as follows:

- 1. That Section 4.24 – Trailers, Box Cars, Sea and Rail Containers be replaced in its entirety with:

**“No person shall park or store on any part of a site, any unlicensed rail or sea container, truck, bus or coach body for the purposes of advertising.**

**That unlicensed rail or sea containers may be allowed for warehousing in all zoning districts, as long as the unit does not display any advertising; is painted in a suitable color and unit is maintained.”**

- 2. That Bylaw 4-2014 be repealed.
- 3. This Bylaw shall come into force on the date of final reading.
