

BYLAW NO. 1 - 76

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

The council of the Town of St. Walburg, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Subject to section 2, no person shall discharge any gun or other firearm, air-gun or spring gun, or any class or type thereof within this town.
2. The council may authorize an officer of the town, in writing, to issue to a recognized gun club or similar organization a permit, in writing, entitling it to operate for the purpose of supervised target practice or similar activities in the town.
3. No such club or organization as set out in section 2 hereof, shall operate at any time without such a permit, and the person in charge shall produce and exhibit his permit when requested to do so by any municipal constable, license inspector, or other authorized person.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this town.
