St. Walburg & District Fire & Rescue Association held their Annual Meeting March 28, 2016. A decision was made to charge \$200 for stand-downs related to Fire Security Alarm Company calls to 911 resulting in dispatch of the fire department. The Department has been getting more and more of these calls. The volunteer fire fighters respond to the call, many times receiving a stand-down call just before arriving at the location. If you have a fire security alarm system please learn the procedure for its operation. If the alarm is a result of a cooking event contact 911 at 306-953-4284 to have them relay to the fire department that this is not an emergency. If you are having callouts because of cooking events please have your fire security alarm

company relocate the sensor to another location. There is one grace call, all others to the same location will be charged at \$200 a call-out.

#### GARBAGE BIN OWNERS:

Public Works may have added an indicator stick to your bin. When you have garbage in the bin please put the stick to the up position. This way on collection day, Public Works will know there is garbage in the bin to be removed. The indicator stick is a wooden stake painted orange at the end. This really helps the fellows during the collection process. Thank you.

#### PLEASE CHECK YOUR SHUT-OFF VALVES BELOW THE WATER METERS.

All properties are to have a functioning shut-off valve below the

town's water meter. Please go down and turn your shut-off valve off and on to ensure it's still functional. If it is not, you are requested to have it replaced. If the shut-off valve doesn't exist, one should be installed.

This shut-off valve is used by the owner or renter of the property to shut the water off should there be a plumbing issue in your building. Should we have to turn the water off at the curb the cost of doing so will be billed to you. During the fall, winter and spring this may involve the cost of a steamer.

Please note: we will not be charging a fee to turn the curb-stop off if you have to replace or add a shut-off valve to your system. If you are a renter of a property, please let your landlord know about this issue.
