

BYLAW NO. 9-85

A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE OPERATION OF BICYCLES.

The Council of the Town of St. Walburg in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw "Municipality" shall mean the Town of St. Walburg.
2. No person shall operate a bicycle on any public sidewalk, ramp or driveway within the municipality.
3. No person shall operate a bicycle without having at least one hand on the handle bar.
4. No person operating a bicycle shall carry any other person thereon unless the bicycle is constructed or equipped for more than one person.
5. No person shall leave a bicycle in a reclining position, or in such a way, as to impede traffic, pedestrian or vehicular.
6. (a) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of Sections (2, 3, 4 & 5) of this bylaw or fails to comply therewith or with any notice given thereunder shall be guilty of an offence and may have their bicycles impounded for a period of:

1st infraction	5 days
2nd infraction	10 days

(b) The Notice of Violation shall be in Form "1" Appendix A, attached to and forming part of this bylaw.



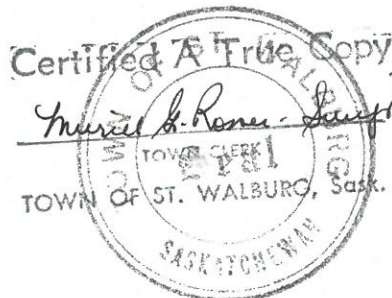
