To be eligible for Best Garden designation, the Town of St. Walburg requires the following information to be submitted no later than June 30, 2021 to the Town Office:

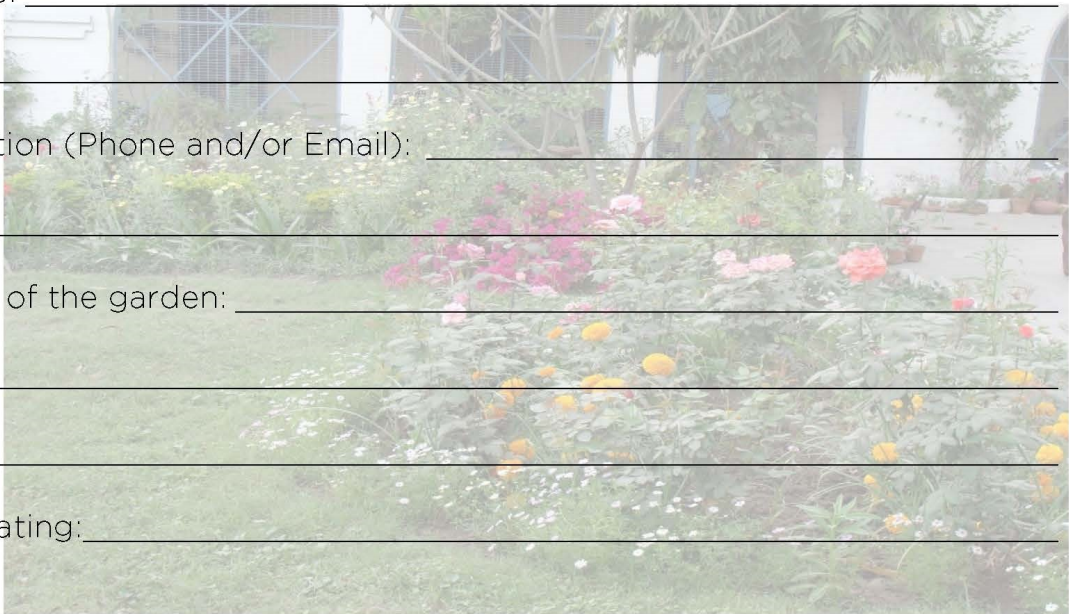

8. Create and confirm a password
9. Verify that you have read the Terms of Service
10. Tap on the next button.
11. An email will be sent to the address you provided.
12. Click or tap on the link in the email to verify it is valid.
13. You can now sign in to your account.

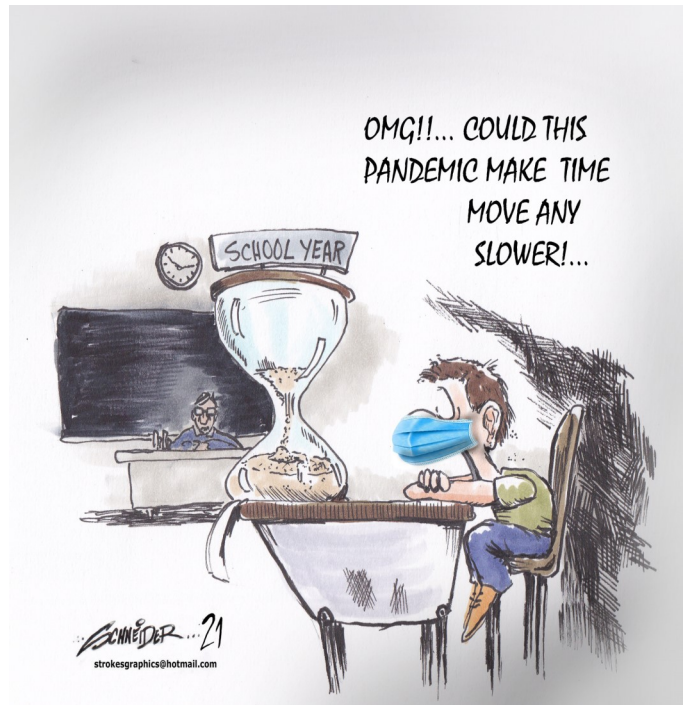
