## ST. Walburg Housing Authority

The St. Walburg Housing Authority is a social program that offers housing to families and seniors with low income as well as people with disabilities. The program subsidizes rent according to the degree of financial need based on 30 percent of income. There are over 300 communities that have local housing authorities. The St. Walburg Board of Directors are Darlene Davidson, Donna Lance, Roger Villeneuve and Paul Schiller as the Chairperson.

Ron Nasby is the Manager of our local housing authority, and he feels that, “our community benefits when there are good homes for seniors, families and people with disabilities.” Ron and the Board of Directors want to leave a positive mark on the future of low income housing by being proactive in realizing the needs of their residents. In speaking with Donna Lance, she emphasized, “we want to be good partners, with our residents and in our community. We are all here to be supportive and to ensure that St. Walburg has housing for all people”. One of their future initiatives is to improve the layout of homes to provide better accessibility and barrier free access. This can mean larger doorways to accommodate wheelchairs or walk in showers for those who have mobility issues. “It is this kind of forward thinking that will move our local housing into the next decade. We need to be always thinking of better ways to work, and by building strong relationships and partnerships both locally and provincially,” expressed Ron Nasby.

The St. Walburg Housing Authority has 7 houses, 10 units in the Manor and 20 Duplex units. ## TRANSIT-VAN

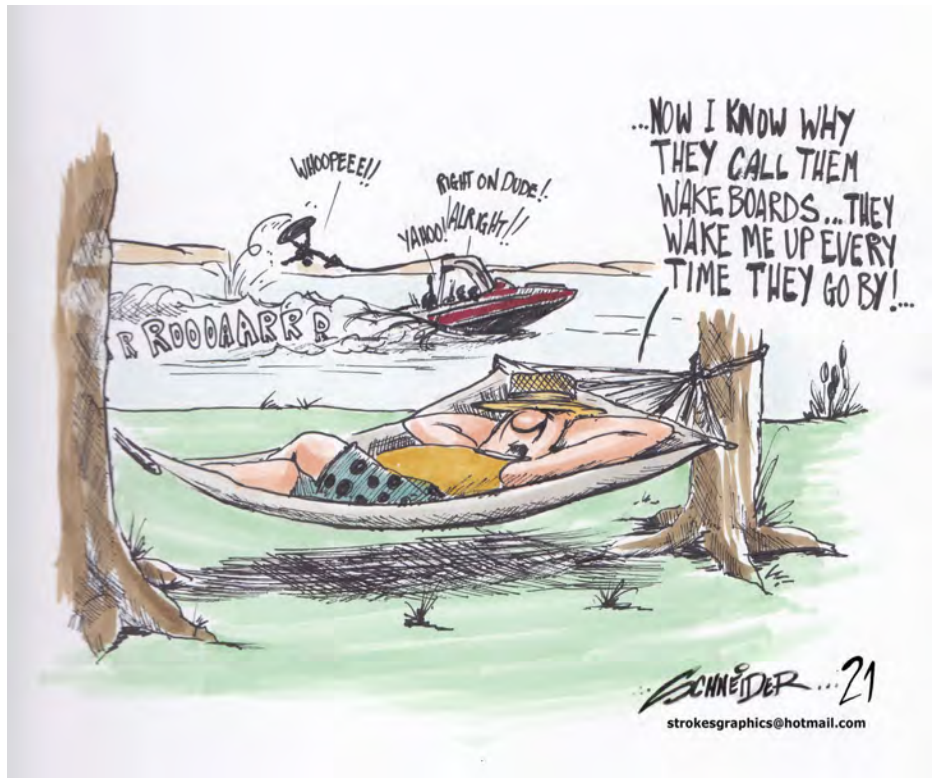

## BULK WATER

Clean, safe potable bulk water is available in St. Walburg at the Water Plant on 4th Street West at a cost of \$9.20 per cubic meter. To purchase water at this self-serve, prepaid station you will need to purchase a preloaded card. Prepaid Water Cards can be purchased at Kim's Service and are preloaded with \$20 credit. You can also purchase prepaid Water Cards (loaded with any amount) at the Town Office during regular business hours that can be reloaded and used indefinitely. Bulk Water cards do require a \$10 deposit per card, that is refundable when returned.
