## MUNICIPAL LIBRARY BYLAW

## NO. 1-70

WHEREAS the municipality of <u>TOWN OF ST. WALBURG</u> , pursuant to The Public Libraries Act, 1969, desires to establish and operate a municipal library to be known as the <u>ST. WALBURG</u> Public Library,
NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN city, town,
OF ST. WALBURG IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACT
AS FOLLOWS:
1. This bylaw shall be known as the Municipal Library Bylaw.
<ol> <li>It shall be lawful for the municipality to establish and operate a municipal library.</li> </ol>
3. The <u>Mayor</u> and <u>Town Clerk</u> are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute the said agreement on behalf of the Council and to attach the Corporate Seal of the municipality thereto and to do or to cause to be done all acts, matters, and things which may be necessary for the development and operation of the said library.
4. The bylaw shall come into force and take effect from and after the day of final passing thereof.
