## TOWN OF ST. WALBURG **BYLAW NO. 14-2004**

## A BYLAW TO AUTHROIZE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS CENTER TO PROVIDE 911 DISPATCH SERVICES.

WHEREAS the Town of St. Walburg is authorized to enter into agreements with a person or association under Section 175(1) of The Urban Municipalities Act, 1984;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to enter into such an agreement with the City of Prince Albert Emergency Communications Center;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of St. Walburg, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Town of St. Walburg is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Prince Albert Emergency Communications Center.

The Mayor and the Administrator are hereby authorized, empowered and directed, to execute the agreement incorporated herewith as Schedule "A" to this bylaw and forming part thereof, and to affix the corporate seal of the Town of St. Walburg and to do and to cause to be done all acts, matters and things which may be necessary for the due performance and fulfillment of the said agreement.
- 3. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect from and after the day of final passing thereof.
