BYLAW 4-84

A BYLAW TO DECLARE DESIRABLE THE UNDERTAKING OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN WORKS AS A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT.

The Council of the Town of St. Walburg in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- The construction of the following local improvement work is hereby declared desirable in the locations hereinafter noted under each work:
 - a) SANITARY SEWERMAINS:
 - Railway Avenue from west boundary of Lot 8, Block 19, west to westerly boundary of Fifth Street West
 - ii) Fourth Street West from Railway Avenue north to alley north of Blocks 19, 20 and 21
 - iii) Fifth Street West from Railway Avenue north to north boundary of alley north of Blocks 19, 20 and 21
 - b) WATERMAINS:
 - i) Railway Avenue from west boundary of Lot 8, Block 19, west to westerly boundary of Fifth Street West
 - ii) Fourth Street West from Railway Avenue north to alley north of Blocks 19, 20 and 21
 - iii) Fifth Street West from Railway Avenue north to north boundary of alley north of Blocks 19, 20 and 21
 - c) SEWER AND WATER SERVICE CONNECTIONS:

Plan B.M. 4676, Block 19, Lot 9 (one connection)

Plan B.M. 4676, Block 20, Lots numbered one to nine inclusive (nine connections)

Plan B.M. 4676, Block 21, Lots numbered one to three inclusive (three connections)

Plan 82-B-85709, Block 17, Lot 10 (one connection)

Plan W.1529, Parcel "C", within the sixty-six (66) feet east from most westerly extension of sewer and water mains on Railway Avenue (one connection)

Pioneer Grain Co. Ltd., Winnipeg, Manitoba, leaseholders on Leases #5618, 8045 and 9399, on CNR station grounds right-of-way, connection at north boundary of alley north of Blocks 19, 20 and 21 and Fifth Street West

2. Subject to the approval of the Local Government Board, the construction of the certain works as described in Section 1 shall be undertaken under the provisions contained in Clasue (e) of Subsection (1) of Section 5 of The Local Improvements Act.
