

BYLAW 6-84

The Council in the Town of St. Walburg in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. No person shall sell, offer for sale or deliver milk within the limits of the Town of St. Walburg unless the milk has been pasteurized in a pasteurization plant approved by the Minister of Health.
2. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of this municipality.
3. This bylaw shall come into effect on, from and after the day and dated upon which the approval of Saskatchewan Health is obtained hereto.

Read three times by unanimous vote and passed by the Council of the Town of St. Walburg, in the Province of Saskatchewan this 14th day of August, A.D. 1984.
