

A BYLAW AUTHORIZING FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION IN THE REGIONAL
PARK AUTHORITY OF BRIGHTSAND LAKE, PURSUANT TO THE
REGIONAL PARKS ACT 1979.

The council of the Town of St. Walburg, in the Province of
Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Approval is given to the participation in a development
plan for new capital development in the Brightsand Lake
Regional Park, as outlined in the development plan
identified as Schedule "A" to this bylaw.
2. Approval is given to the financial participation in the
capital development program as outlined in the financial
program as set out in Schedule "B" to this bylaw, to
commence on April 1, 1980.
3. The annual financial contributions per year, for a term
of five years, commencing April 1, 1980, shall be as follows:
 - (a) capital development - Two hundred and sixty-four
Dollars (\$ 264.00)
 - (b) maintenance and operating expenses - Nil (\$ Nil)
4. That application be made under the provisions of
section 5 of The Regional Parks Act 1979, in the form
attached as Schedule "C" to this bylaw.
5. Bylaw No. 13-75 is repealed, effective March 31, 1980.

- I. THE COUNCIL WILL ADHERE TO ALL FINANCIAL OR CONTRIBUTED COMMITMENTS AS OUTLINED IN BYLAW NO. 7-79.
- II. THE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAMS SHALL BE RESTRICTED TO LANDS DESIGNATED AS BRIGHT SAND LAKE REGIONAL PARK AND DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:
