

BYLAW 8-84

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ST. WALBURG TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION OF SEWER MAINS
AS A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT

1. That the construction is hereby authorized of sewer mains on

Street	From	To
Railway Avenue	West Property Line of Lot 8, Block 19	West Property Line of Fifth Street West
Fourth Street West	Railway Avenue	CNR Station Grounds
Fifth Street West	Railway Avenue	CNR Station Grounds

at an estimated cost of \$26,500.00; the sum of \$7,337.65 is to be paid by the town at large and the sum of \$19,162.35 is to be raised by special frontage assessments against the lots abutting directly on the streets whereon sewer mains are constructed according to the extent of their respective frontage thereon.

- The estimated special annual rate per meter frontage to be paid during the period of ten (10) years is eleven dollars and fifty cents (\$11.50).
- The mayor and town clerk of the Town of St. Walburg are hereby authorized and empowered to raise from time to time by way of temporary loans or advances from any bank or person an amount sufficient to meet the cost of the work pending the completion thereof, and such loans or advances shall be, and are hereby created a first charge upon the proceeds of any sale of debentures hereafter issued to repay the amount of said temporary loans or advances.
- For the purpose of effecting such loans or advances the said mayor and town clerk are hereby authorized to sign promissory note or notes, or any renewals thereof and to affix the corporate seal to any such promissory note or notes or any renewal or renewals thereof.
- The life-time of the said work as estimated by the municipal engineer is fifteen (15) years.
