


Yearly, the Museum, recognizes a local historical event, artifacts and the people who made it all happen, with a new and unique display.

COMMUNITY WELL

The RM of Frenchman Butte No. 501 has granted permission to any resident within their boundaries to use the Community Wells. The closest well to St. Walburg is west of the Municipal Cemetery on Highway 26 South. Community wells are non-potable water intended for agriculture use. There are two Community Wells located within the RM of Frenchman Butte No. 50I:

NE 29-53-22 W3 & SW 35-53-24 W3.

BULK WATER

Clean, safe potable bulk water is available in St. Walburg at the Water Plant on 4th Street West at a cost of \$9.48 per cubic meter. To purchase water at this self-serve, prepaid station you will need to purchase a preloaded card. Prepaid Water Cards can be purchased at Kim's Service and are preloaded with \$20 credit. You can also purchase prepaid Water Cards (loaded with any amount) at the Town Office during regular business hours that can be reloaded and used indefinitely. Bulk Water cards do require a \$10 deposit per card, that is refundable when returned.

CIVIC ADDRESS

Your civic number is the main physical feature used by emergency responders when locating the source of a 9-1-1 call.

Every owner of a residence or business must display the civic address number so it is clearly visible from the main roadway. This allows emergency responders to find the address quickly in an emergency.
